3. We won't ask for a hypothesis or data– just your ability to explain the emerging tech you have with you and why it excites you in the education/performance realm.

PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS: [Proposal Submission – Click Here](#)

1. An Abstract: 400 words (maximum) organized by these subheadings:
 - a) MY MAGIC TECH- a specific technology (hardware or software product or a process) that excites you;
 - b) MY TEAM - Your name and your vendor (or associate) name and organizations;
 - c) WHY OTHERS NEED EXPOSURE TO THIS - a rationale telling why either educators, designers, developers, teachers, instructors, trainers – need exposure to this toy and to your ideas for it;
 - d) IMPACT -How may this technology change teaching/learning practice, specifically? Near term? Long term? In what context (education, performance, design, teaching, instruction, military, home use, mobile worlds, virtual worlds, business, government – anywhere)?
2. Your passion and your functioning technology / toy/ item on the convention floor.
